### CONFIRMATION



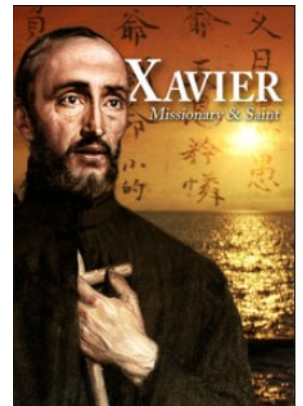
Celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation in two services.

2020 Bursary**

**WEBINAR - Anti-Human Trafficking - OCT 19, 2020 at 7:00 pm**

The Anti-Human Trafficking (AHT) Committee of the Archdiocese of Vancouver is coordinating with our Diocesan CWL to provide a Webinar for all parishioners of St. Charles Garnier Church.

This presentation will outline the definition of sex trafficking, CWL and other Catholic responses and actions and exploration of the Protection of Communities and Exploited Persons Act. They will outline AHT Committee actions on the issue of prostitution and sex trafficking and look at the current reality, with a call to action. The presentation is meant to give hope that actions and solutions to these problems can be found. The format is a webinar (to be accessed on your computer) with participants able to view and listen only, with no video or audio of the attendees. The moderator will pass along any questions to the presenters through the "chat" feature.
