Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord!

This week's scriptures invite us to develop empathy towards 'Socially isolated people' (beggars, blind people, mentally challenged persons & etc.,) How do we treat them? Oftentimes we do not wish to befriend them or simply avoid them. WHO explains that there are about 34 million blind people available now in the world and another 116 million will join this group sooner or later due to glaucoma and other vision related disorders? Today's Gospel explains the life of Bartimaeus son of Timaeus, a blind beggar. Bartimaeus accepted his condition of blindness. He wanted to make a living by begging and was not intimidated by other's power and control. He had the courage to seek Jesus and was able to ask for help and in fact Jesus helped him with his healing touch.

Today's scriptures also speak to us about our inner perception of certain events both in our life and in our circumstances. We believe that certain things matter to be true, but we do not have enough resources to prove. Therefore, we do not have all the answers to problems and issues. Let us consider: Whether the church has all the answers for the problem of life, after death and so on? We are trying to explore the possibilities from the scriptures and from our known world through intellectual inquiry. We have to remind ourselves that oftentimes we are blinded by our own opinions or perceptions. There may be a possibility to improve, modify and change or correct our opinions at a certain point of time.

What about our 'tunnel vision or one-dimensional vision?'. This is a crooked way of thinking and understanding people and events. We judge people and events according to our level of intelligence or

perception. Are we not carried away to judge people according to their status, power, prestige, talents, fame or ability (skill) to interact & entertain others? Tunnel vision is an extremely narrow or prejudiced outlook. It's like looking through the tube (there's no comprehensive outlook). It is thinking about one thing only or being preoccupied with a particular aspect of the problem.

The Pharisees were totally blinded by their tunnel vision about the Messiah. They could not think high of Jesus. They just perceived him to be one of them/an ordinary Jewish man claiming to be the Messiah. They could not figure out the goodness of Jesus. They were highly offended when Jesus modified their customs, traditions and their laws. In fact, they developed a 'mindset to oppose each and every action of Jesus. When people are unable to see or perceive beyond the ordinary things, any amount of convincing would be a futile effort. They have made up their mind. Therefore, Jesus said, "Blind leading the blind". Tunnel vision leads to 'rigidity', unwilling to accept suggestions to change our action plans. My way or the high- way' leads to catastrophic outcomes.

Consider the 'Spiritual Blindness". Spiritual blindness is 'not receptive to God's Graces and Gifts' (unable to perceive and respond to God's promptings) Bartimaeus suffered physical blindness, but spiritually he was very sharp & enlightened to recognize Jesus as the Messiah. The Pharisaic cohort was totally blind to understand the marvelous deeds of God in Jesus. Gift of understanding is the power of the Holy Spirit. Those who are spiritually blind do not seek the help of the Holy Spirit. Ephesians 1:18 tells us to seek God's help: 'Let the eyes of our mind be enlightened' to see the goodness of God in and around us. All the best!






