## PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord!

This week's Scriptures highlight the Blessings and Challenges of Marital Life. Marriage is a blessing when it is lived out with greater and deeper love. Otherwise, it begins to struggle and becomes a challenge due to difficulties the spouses undergo. In the modern World we have 1.2 Billion Catholics and 3.4 Billion Christians. In 1970 there were 3.725 million Catholic marriages. But it dropped to 2.486 million in 2015. Every year there is a decrease in the Catholic church marriages. The total Divorce rate in the Western European World is 30% Belgium records 70% Portugal 60% UK & N. America records 50% and it is very much high in Canada.

Christopher West in his 'Theology of the Body', a teaching by Pope John Paul II wrote, "Marriage is an Authentic Expression of Love". According to him, the marriage relationship is authentic when it is motivated by love that is genuine and trustworthy. Otherwise, it is an artificial love or arbitrary love. Authentic love leads to Sanctity of Marriage. Artificial love leads to gratification of one's desires called lust. When marriage is not authentic, that is contracted for convenience and once that convenience is over, the marriage falls apart and ends up.

Globe and Mail brought out an article about the Changing Nature of Family Dynamics in Canada. Canadian Families are complex in its nature and reality, explained this article. (Due to various types of unions such as ..Same Sex Marriages, Common Law Families, Single parent or family households, Step Father or Mother Families). It also talked about 'multigenerational families, foster children's families and sand-witch generation families.

It summarized that Canadian family models are both exciting and Challenging. Exciting because of its variety and challenging because it is oftentimes unstable.

Because of this instability, Canada's birth rate is decreasing drastically and birth outside of marriage is on the rise. It increases in the Industrial World. Single parent households are on the increase. This type of family life is a conscious choice among young adults, because it gives them independence for other reasons such as education or occupational reasons. Therefore, marriage becomes a challenge when it is contracted for 'Social Convenience', says Pope Francis. Special consideration like wealth, prestige, status and property occupies the prime place and love falls short. When expectations are not realized or satisfied, conflicts arise and lead ultimately to broken relationships soon to end/wind up their union.

Today's scriptures talk about marriages. "God created humans with a purpose of uniting them together". Man is incomplete without the woman and the woman is incomplete without the man. That's why God created Male and Female. Therefore, their union is Sacred and it should be esteemed as the highest calling of humans to form relationships. We sensitively remember the following expression: "Bone of my bone and Flesh of my flesh" (Ge 2:23) But modern reality is stunning and astonishing. Because of the high standard of this relationship with its demands, the Institutional Marriages are crumbling. Many have left the church because the Church teachings on marriage seem to be too hard for people to follow & practice.

Today's Scriptures are not meant to be a painful reminder of the effects of divorce, which can wound us so deeply, rather, it invites us to ponder absolute faithfulness of God's Love for each one of us, a love so powerful that it brims over and touches others. May God bless all our parish families and protect them to be a solid role model of love and belonging for everyone.

## Statement of Apology by the Catholic Bishop of Canada to the Indigenous Peoples of this Land:

The Catholic Bishops of Canada, gathered in Plenary this week, took the opportunity to affirm and acknowledge to the Indigenous Peoples the suffering experienced in Canada's Indian Residential Schools. Many Catholic religious communities and dioceses participated in this system, which led to the suppression of Indigenous languages, culture and spirituality, failing to respect the rich history, traditions and wisdom of Indigenous Peoples. They acknowledged the grave abuses that were committed by some members of our Catholic community; physical, psychological, emotional, spiritual, cultural, and sexual. They also sorrowfully acknowledged the historical and ongoing trauma and the legacy of suffering and challenges faced by Indigenous Peoples that continue to this day. Along with those Catholic entities which were directly involved in the operation of the schools and which have already offered their own heartfelt apologies, the Catholic Bishops of Canada expressed their profound remorse and apologized unequivocally. Together with the many pastoral initiatives already underway in dioceses across the country, the Bishops pledged to undertake fundraising in each region of the country to support initiatives discerned locally with Indigenous partners. Furthermore, they invited the Indigenous Peoples to journey with us into a new era of reconciliation, helping us to prioritize initiatives of healing, to listen to the experience of Indigenous Peoples, especially to the survivors of Indian Residential Schools, and to educate our clergy, consecrated men and women, and lay faithful, on Indigenous cultures and spirituality. They further committed to continue the work of providing documentation or records that will assist in the memorialization of those buried in unmarked graves. A delegation of Indigenous survivors, Elders/knowledge keepers, and youth will meet with the Holy Father in December 2021. Pope Francis will encounter and listen to the Indigenous Peoples, so as to discern how he can support our common desire to renew relationships and walk together along the path of hope in the coming years. The Bishops of Canada have pledged to work with the Holy See and our Indigenous partners on the possibility of a pastoral visit by the Pope to Canada as part of this healing journey. We are committed to continue the journey with the First Nations, Métis and Inuit Peoples of this land. For more information, please contact the diocese or visit <u>www.cccb.ca</u>.
