PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ!

May the Lord give you Peace! "Psalm 57:6 exhorts us not to hurt anyone. "Do not dig a pit for someone's fall into it. Know that such a person who digs a pit will certainly fall into it". Human Society is made up of several types of people such as good, bad, evil, treacherous, hurtful, arrogant & saintly invested with forgiving skills.

To-day's Scriptures call us to forgive those who hurt us or anger us in some way or other. Oftentimes we hold grudges and continue with this feeling even up to death. Mark Twin wrote, "I might carry this hurt even when I am buried 6 feet under the earth in my grave".

It's a good thought to Forgive those who have offended us. I read a message in the FaceBook the other day, "Only strong people have the power to forgive their offenders & the weak people hold on to their grudges" and roll in pain every night in their bed. Job recognized this and confessed that 'my heart palpitates all the night as a loom runs endlessly' causing me stress and strain with sleepless nights.

Withholding 'forgiveness' leads to physical and psychological disorders causing untold burdens. Such people live, move, and appear to be happy outwardly. Psalm 51:3 reminds us of their condition, "My failure to forgive is always before me" (My sins is always before me. I know I have sinned against you alone) The Soul of such persons are troubled and God keeps on reminding such individuals of that missed opportunity.






