PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters & Brothers in Christ!

This week's Scriptures invite us for a 'Life of Servant Leadership'. Jesus envisioned his followers to become first of all 'a child and then a servant'. A child is the least and most vulnerable person in society. A leader is the one who has power and authority to discern, decide and execute. The Gospel of Mark 9:30-37 has a great link in this passage for a child and servant with the use of the Aramaic Word 'Talya' which gives the meaning Child & Servant. Therefore, Jesus is calling his Apostles and Disciples to accept the responsibility of Servanthood towards the least and most vulnerable in Society.

We are called for a "Honourable Life". Our actions should speak louder than our words. Let our words and actions corroborate and be ready and willing to face the inconvenient truth of criticism. People may test us with insult and torture. They may give untold pain and misery by creating the awkward situation of enmity and hatred. Spreading concocted stories, fabricating and spreading falsehoods to prove their point. We may be accused of mistrust and branded as 'cannot be trusted any longer'. Sometimes people could even create confusion in society to achieve their selfish ends by spreading unfounded charges to achieve their selfish ends.

Indeed, people can test the patience and forbearance of the sufferer by condemning those who are not on their side and cause great damage to their reputation by shaming them with all types of accusations as that of Jesus. Therefore, their desire is to silence the voice of those who reproach them of their wicked deeds. How do we counter the influence of such evils in our communities?

St. James 3:16-4.3 advises to 'seek the wisdom from above'. This wisdom will bring with it some amazing positive effects upon the community: Peace, Gentleness, Mercy, etc. Jesus said, "Whoever welcomes one little child in my name, welcomes me" (Mk 9:30-37) We all struggle to understand Jesus' mandate. We are invited to become the Guardians & champions of the Vulnerable people especially those who give us problems and cause challenges and also the oppressed, suppressed, marginalized, alienated and displaced, most of all the disadvantaged ones.

We are reminded of our Christian Responsibility to accept the littles ones lovingly without hurting and alienating them. Today's Scriptures call us to discover the plain human decency and kindness towards others. This is what Jesus wishes to be as His Child and Disciple. St. James repeats in 1:27 "Pure Religion is based on Social Justice". We have a moral obligation to care for the less fortunate disciples of Christ and that encompasses our Servant Leadership.
