PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters & Brothers in the Lord!

This weekend liturgy sends out a profound message on 'the evening of life' (Mt 20:8) "Call the workers and pay them their wages". St. John of the Cross a Carmelite mystic (1542-1591 Dark Night of the Soul) wrote, "In the evening of life, we will be judged by love alone".

In the final moments of our earthly existence or our closing journey of life, we would be called out by God, by our name as our names are written in the Book of Life (Ex 32:32) 'because they have washed their robes in the blood of the Lamb' (Rev 7:14)

"On that day", Mother Thresa of Calcutta explains, "The measure of our love will decide the measure of our happiness". God will not ask us to explain how much wealth we have accumulated, professional titles we obtained, properties bought, travels undertaken, successes achieved, honor & medals won but how much did we love, share, overcome egoism, transform the lives of others, build bridges of friendship, extend our hearts & develop the unquenchable thirst of love that we received from the Creator God himself".

The advice of St. John of the Cross is worth remembering "Where there is no love, put love and you will find love. Love is repaid by love alone. At the end of the day, we will be examined by Love. When we experience something unpleasant let us look at the Cross in which Jesus was Crucified & be silent before him to capture the intensity of His Love".

The Dark Night of the Soul which he wrote about the "Wilderness experience" further explains the longing of the soul based on Isaiah 40:3 "Let God's Voice be heard in our Conscience (wilderness)" is the ultimate goal of the evening of life.

Red: Do not be seated.


Green: Be seated. **Blue:** Special needs.






