PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord!

The essence of the Good News is 'Divine Mercy'. God's mercy breaks-through all barriers /hurdles/ limitations/restrictions and road-blocks. God's mercy is Universal and Overwhelmingly Surprising. Mercy is for all and no one is excluded from the mercy of God. Conversion of heart (metonia)/turning away from faults/failures/mistakes/offenses (sins) and turning towards God is a prerequisite to experience the mercy of God. Our willingness to follow God's lead and to experience His Mercy is essential to have joy, peace and happiness in life.

'Amazing Grace' is a vibrant hymn that expresses the mercy and compassion of God wonderfully. 'Compassion' is a deep feeling/awareness of someone's agonizing pain/situation while 'Mercy' is the treatment of that person with gentleness/humanity/tolerance/goodwill/leniency/

softheartedness and empathy. Compassion is indeed a strong feeling of sympathy...'moved with pity' Lk 15:20 (tenderhearted) while 'mercy' is a strong desire to help alleviate their agony/situation. Mercy is kindness/clemency exercised/ manifested towards the miserable. It includes pity/ forbearance & gentleness. God's mercy is flowing from His tenderhearted. Micah 6:8 "What does God ask of you?".

1.Act Justly **2.** Love Tenderly & **3.** Walk Humbly with the Lord.

Mercy is the essence of the Good News/Gospel. Lk 6:36 "Be Merciful as your Heavenly Father is Merciful". (Mt 9:13 "I desire mercy not sacrifice")

What's mercy then? 'Mercy is Grace' freely given. Ephesians 2:4-9 Paul wrote, "Though we are sinners, God showed us mercy. He brought us to life with

Christ". Mercy and Compassion are like the 2 sides of a coin. The Hebrew word 'Hesed' when translated into English gives the meaning "Love" is the highest expression of mercy according to the Bible. It expressed 'God's Loving Kindness to humanity'. Love is the movement of the Will that motivated God to establish a relationship with the humans when He sent His Son with a Mission. (Jn 3:16) This expresses His Covenantal Love, Steadfast Love for all Eternity.

'Hesed' is kindness to all people and our commitment in Christ should motivate us to go beyond the minimum or ordinary requirement/duties of everyday life. It should urge us (2 Cor 5:4) to love everyone and most of all those in dire need and commit ourselves to alleviate their suffering. Mercy is therefore a 'Charism'/Gift (Rm12:8) and Paul invites us to perform acts of Mercy Cheerfully and not with a Sorrowful Face. In our Good Friday Celebration, we expose the veiled Cross of Christ to the faithful. 'The Cross is the Mercy Seat' for all believers. Jesus died for us in order that we may gain access to God's Clemency/Freedom and Heavenly Life in His Presence. Therefore 'Mercy is the Divine Plan of God' and we humans participate in this 'Divine Plan through our Faith in Christ!'.



CARE OF CREATION


