PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Prophet Isaiah was called by God around 742 B.C to exercise his ministry in and around Jerusalem. In today's Scripture (Is 35:1-6 &10), he introduces the theme of 'Joy and the Restoration of Israel'. "The Wilderness and the dry land shall be glad, the desert shall rejoice and blossom abundantly, and rejoice with joy and singing", expressing the 'exultant outburst of joy' (40:3-5, & 43:19) "I am doing a new deed, even now it comes to light; can you not see it? Yes, I am making a road in the wilderness, path in the wilds". On that occasion 'the eyes of the blind will be opened' (most unfortunate people among the exiled ones will be among the first to experience the vindication of the Lord). The God of Israel will give Victory and Salvation for the redeemed by releasing them from the tyranny of their oppressors.

Today we celebrate the 'Gaudete Sunday / Joy Sunday' in honor of Mother Mary, who is with the Child. The Church calls her children 'to rejoice with this expectant mother' as human families rejoice with their daughters of this nature. 'Joy is the Gift of the Holy Spirit'. Luke 24:50 "Great Joy Filled their hearts". Joy makes everyone stronger & greater, since joy is a personal & individual experience. It can be a community experience too, like the National Joy of victory or achievement. 'GRACE' is the word which is associated with JOY. Joy is the 'favour or benevolence of God'. God selected Mary as the recipient of this joy. She was singled out from all the other women-folk of the world to respond to God. LK 1: 31ff "Mary, do not be afraid; you have won God's favor. You are to conceive and bear a Son. He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High". Mary in humility accepted to become the recipient of God's

grace & favor. The Immaculate virgin joyfully conceived Jesus by the Holy Spirit. Let us imagine the Joy in the heart of Mary. It was unexpected but exhilarating & exciting!

She was able to share this Joy with her elderly cousin Elizabeth at her Visitation. The Immaculate virgin Mary was joyfully carrying Jesus when she visited with Elizabeth. Charity and Love inspired her visit. The Immaculate Mother joyfully brought Jesus into the World. The Angel of the Lord appeared to the Shepherds and announced, "Do not be afraid. Listen, I bring you good news of great joy, a joy to be shared by the whole people. Today in the City of David, a Saviour has been born. He is Christ the Lord". (Lk 2:10-12) Every mother share that joy of motherhood. Mary experienced her motherhood in all her innocence and sweetness. She experienced the holy happiness of bringing into the world the Son of God, who was to be the Redeemer and Saviour of all. The Virgin Mother joyfully exhibited Jesus, her Son, to the adoration of the Magi. Every mother delight in her (child) son/daughter, to those who come to visit the family especially friends, neighbours and acquaintances. It was an exhilarating experience to Mary & Joseph to receive the Three Magi from the East, who came thousands of miles to adore & honor the infant, bringing gifts of high quality.

Mary joyfully found Jesus in the Jerusalem Temple after his three-day loss. Losing a child at a tender age is a pain to the family, but finding him/ her gives them great joy. Mary's joy was overwhelming when she met Jesus among the Teachers of the Law, engaged in deliberation, 'asking them questions and answering them at a tender age. Probably she would have felt that her son was a 'prodigy' & that would have boosted her personality. Mary might have felt such a bliss when she found Jesus in the Temple. Mary had the privilege of sharing her son's special moments before his death and after his resurrection. The Church teaches that she is the 'co-redemptorist' of our Salvation. She beheld her son after his resurrection. We do not have adequate words to express her maternal Joy of this 'Heroic Son'. Her joy, by way of contrast with the grief of the First Good Friday, was supreme, hair-rising & unfathomable. Finally, she was joyfully reunited with her Son in Heaven as the Queen of the Redeemed & Queen of the world. Joy is experienced by those who have peace in their hearts. Mary had that Peace and she was a Peaceful & Joyful Mother for all who love & honor her. Let us Love and honor her all our days! Affectionately in Jesus! Fr. Gabriel

DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE

What is COP 15? It is about protecting biodiversity and it's happening right now in Montreal. Biodiversity concerns everything we eat or drink, plants, animals, water, trees, medicines. We need to heed Pope Francis' call to all the churches to protect biodiversity in all we do and buy or don't buy. We can act by writing to our political representatives urging action, not just words.

In Advent we are preparing for the coming of God into the world as a poor person, born in a stable, his parents almost immediately fleeing with him to Egypt as a refugees to protect the Saviour of the world, who promises to bring justice to the poor. We are Jesus' hands in this world. It's up to us to act.

One useful action is to sign the Development and Peace petition for better laws for Canadian mining companies working outside of Canada—People and Planet First. Another is to write to your representative in Ottawa urging action on COP 15, not just promises.
