Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Prophet Nathan brought out a timely message for the people of Israel and to King David's dynasty through King Ahaz (2 Samuel 7:12-16) "Yahweh will make you a House. I will preserve the offspring of your body after you, and make his sovereignty secure. It is He who shall build a house for my name, and I will make his royal throne secure forever) I will be a father to him, and he a son to me. I will not withdraw my favor from him. Your house and your sovereignty will always stand secure before me and your throne established forever'.

This child is the symbol of God's favor, blessing & presence among his people. His name will be 'Immanuel', which is, 'God is with us'. Immanuel becomes the definitive presence of God among His people. Pope Benedict XVI in his 'Caritas Deus Est' wrote, 'Immanuel is the face of God / He is the Revealer of the Father's Face / Love'.

Isaiah the great prophet of Israel wrote between 801 -780 B.C about the Deep & Abiding care of God's Love to his people. He always surrounds us with His amazing presence. "Where can I run from your presence? If I climb the heavens, you are there, where could I go to escape your Spirit? Even if I lie in the underworld / sheol / netherworld you are there'. (Ps 139: 7-8)

Therefore, Psalm 24 recommends and admonishes all the faithful to follow the teachings of God in order to have His love shine on them, especially to have a clear Conscience (purity of heart), freedom from bribery, refraining from idol worship /false Gods and not to give in to false witness (don't engage in false witness at any time). If we continue to follow the guidance of the Lord, He will Bless His Children with Prosperity.

The Apostle Mathew made Joseph, the husband of Mary as the 'Central and Active figure of God's Grace (recipient of God's revelation) in the Birth of Christ, Immanuel, God With Us!' He was a Just Man /a righteous person who lived according to the teachings of the Torah. 'Divinity blesses those who are able to live a righteous life' (right living according to God's principles) Joseph's righteousness was the key point of his unwillingness to expose his wife Mary for public disgrace. He had the sensitivity 'to wait on God for guidance' when he was burdened with this challenging thought of Mary's pregnancy. Indeed, Joseph was confused and perplexed. But he was humble enough to seek the guidance of God.

Today's Scripture teaches a life lesson for all. When we are faced with a life-threatening question or predicament in life, we need to lean on God for clarity and guidance like Joseph and King Ahaz. The 'Birth of Christ' in the human world is God's Intervention. Christ is conceived by the Holy Spirit.

Jesus means 'Immanuel', meaning 'Savior / God is with us'. Ultimately God is with His people. This God saves everyone from every possible challenge or misery provided they come to Him and Trust in Him. There's no other name in the entire world, except the name of Jesus which could save God's people. How fortunate we are to belong to this great community of faith. May His Holy Birth Bless everyone with Peace, Health & Prosperity!



DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE

What is COP 15? It is about protecting biodiversity and it's happening right now in Montreal. Biodiversity concerns everything we eat or drink, plants, animals, water, trees, medicines. We need to heed Pope Francis' call to all the churches to protect biodiversity in all we do and buy or don't buy. We can act by writing to our political representatives urging action, not just words. In Advent we are preparing for the coming of God into the world as a poor person, born in a stable, his parents almost immediately fleeing with him to Egypt as a refugees to protect the Saviour of the world, who promises to bring justice to the poor. We are Jesus' hands in this world. It's up to us to act.

One useful action is to sign the Development and Peace petition for better laws for Canadian mining companies working outside of Canada—People and Planet First. Another is to write to your representative in Ottawa urging action on COP 15, not just promises. See the link below for prayers for this month.


