It's a great joy to Celebrate the Motherhood of Our Blessed Mother Mary, as the "Holy Mother of the Redeemer Jesus Christ", this first day of the Civic Year 2023. Today we also pause to pray for 'World Peace', as we 'Inaugurate the New Civic Year 2023'. This year we will be celebrating the 156th year of 'Our Great Nation Canada'. His Holiness, Pope Francis invites & encourages everyone to pray for World Peace, as we pass through an unhealthy human made war between Ukraine & Russia. Peace is becoming a 'mirage' in the modern world because of the escalation of tension everywhere. Peace is not the absence of war, as the war has become a reality even after

- If anyone wishes to prepare the Confirmation Class of our Parish Youth for the coming year, kindly stop by Fr. Gabriel and explore the possibilities.


