PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This week's Scripture honors the 'Star of Bethlehem' (Numbers 24:17) "A Star from Jacob takes Leadership & a Sceptre arises from Israel". Mathew 2:1-12 Reports that the Magi from the East, arriving at Jerusalem asked King Herod, "Where is the infant king of the Jews? We saw 'his star, as it rose' and have come to do him homage".

People of that time believed that each one born in the World had a Star / represented by a Star, that might appear at their birth. Mathew here refers to the astrological knowledge of the Magi (probably these men are from Mesopotamia, the home of astrology) 'His Star' is the Star of Bethlehem, which is an allusion to King David. The Magi sought the King in their search and they consulted Herod, the King of Israel. The King was curious to know the Truth about this Infant and so he called the Experts of Judaism to carefully find out about it.

The experts of Judaism came to the conclusion according to the Book of the Prophet Micah 5:1-3 "Bethlehem of Judea" the birthplace of King David (2 Samuel 5:2), which became the place of Origin of the King Messiah of the Future. The Star led them to the manger and they saw the Child with His Parents and Presented the Child with 'Gold (Royalty) Frankincense (Divinity) Myrth (Humanity) These gifts reveal the theme of Royal Messiahship of Jesus along with their Adoration of the Baby Jesus)


The Magi were known as Astrologers, Kings, Foreigners, Gentiles, Pagan Priests, Visionaries and Witness to the Manifestation of God. Undoubtedly, we could conclude that these were brave people who explored the unknown, through their unplanned journey.


They never had a map for direction or a GPS to guide their way. But they had the curiosity to explore what was happening in the World. They just observed the Sky and saw an unusual Star and perceived as if something of importance was happening and they pursued their quest. Probably they would have had a hazardous journey with animals as their transportation, as there were no Aeroplane or Helicopter at that time. But they had an unquenchable enthusiasm and optimism for adventure. These men were from the East as per the gospel of Mathew. Biblical experts attest to the traditional belief that they sprang from 1. Persia (Melchior) 2.India (Caspar) & 3. Arabia (Balthazar).

Today we reflect the theme that 'God reveals himself to those who have a sincere heart'. These men had a sincere heart to seek and find the presence of God. They were guided by the Star, to behold the face of the Child Jesus at Bethlehem. If we have the same attitude and search for the presence of God with a sincere heart, we too will be able to behold the face of God. St. Paul in the letter to the Ephesians affirms that God's Kingdom is Universal and God Welcomes everyone into his company if we express a sincere desire to belong to him. Epiphany invites us to feel the presence of God in our lives and share that experience with others to help bring them to God's presence. Let us open our heart's doors to others like Mother Mary, who opened her heart, mind and being to God.
