PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Solemnity of Christ the King!"

"Are you the King of the Jews?" (Jn 18:33) Pilate inquired of Christ. When the Magi arrived in Jerusalem from the East asked King Herod, "Where is the infant King of the Jews?". (Mt 2:2) Apostle John Wrote in his gospel 3:17 " God sent his Son into the World not to condemn it, but through him the world might be saved". The purpose of Christ's coming into the World is to set an example of leadership and guide the world & its people to live harmoniously in fraternal charity. The historical Kings & Queens have become a thing of the past and now we have Elected officials who are invested with the authority of governing their countries and their people. But oftentimes they seem to be corrupt due to excessive power & wealth. They derail quickly from their promises in order to make themselves important. The Servant Leadership has given way to a Military type of leadership paving the way to anarchy. Therefore, moderners do not like either the rule of the Kings & Queens of the past, or the modern elected Political Leaders like the Presidents and Prime Ministers of the Nations.

Pope Pius XI established 'The Feast of Christ the King' to give the World a Role Model of Leadership after WW I. The 2nd Book of Samuel explains the vision of God when He opted David, (the shepherd boy from Bethlehem) to become the King of Israel. God's concern was not solely to appoint the strongest male warrior to rule over his subjects. Rather, God sought first a "Shepherd, for His People". God praised King David saying, 'a shepherd after my own heart'. (). Jesus rejected all domination. He served as a very example of service to the less

fortunate, excluded and alienated. Jesus gave a great role model of leadership.

Jesus established a Kingdom of "Peace, Justice & Love" (Rm 14:17) He never thought about Military power, violence and weapons of mass destruction like the 'atom bomb or nuclear missiles and warheads'. But all the while, he spoke about 'mercy of God and compassion' to forgive and with empathy & to accept the offender. He made a difference in leadership qualities and was considered to be the Real Role Model for the Modern World Leaders'. It's no wonder Christians worship Christ as their 'Lord & King' on this day. He is the 'King of the Universe because He is the Good Shepherd'.

Jesus was born in a rural setting, but he was not a tribal leader. His principles and value systems were explained in the Gospel of Mathew 5:1-12. Even today his principles are highly valued and accepted by the citizens of the World. So, he is a global personality and indeed a 'Vibrant Global Leader'. He led people by example. He was willing to relent, tolerate, forgive and accept without any prejudice. He accepted everyone as they are and with unconditional love, he connected with all, especially the 'anawim' the little ones. He met people at their crossroads. He did not wait for them to come to him rather he went after them searching. In the words of Pope Francis, "He went to the Peripheries Searching".

He had a great Team of Disciples with varied mindsets, but united for a single purpose, "To give expression to the kingdom of God", through love and service. All these men are stalwarts. Even after 2000 years, we remember them for their nobility of heart and simplicity of spirit. They were willing to die on behalf of Jesus, their master for his principles and values. Today we imitate Jesus' Leadership imploring Him to inspire & motivate our World Leaders to live their sacred call to the best of their ability manifesting their goodwill. May Christ the King Bless all our Civic & Religious Leaders!

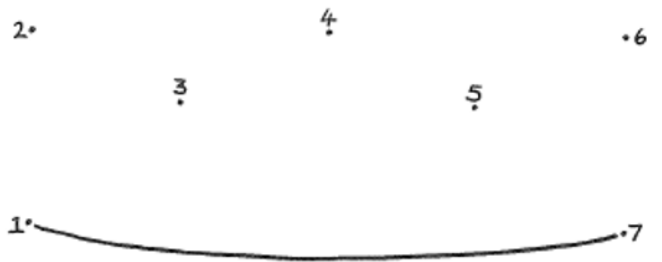

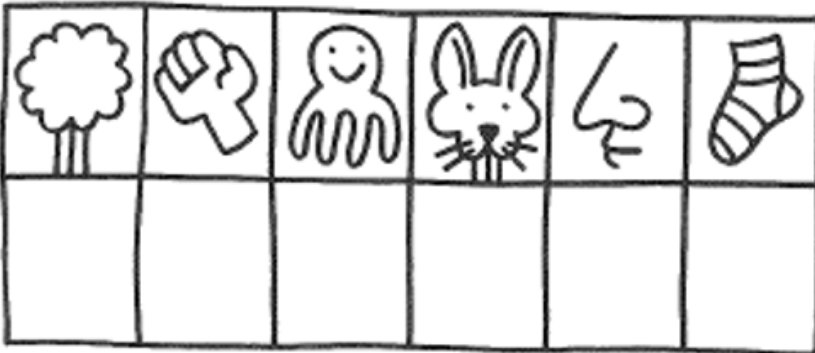
