



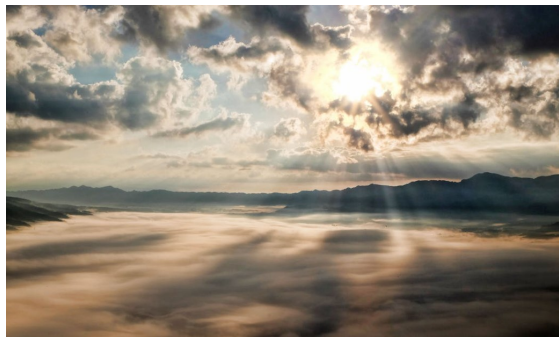

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear brothers and sisters in the Lord,
 "Our participation in Christ's Resurrection is vital for our Eternal Life" is the central message that we get from this week's scriptures. We are reminded by the Church to update our 'Basic Christian Faith' that is, 'Jesus is the Christ and God Raised Him from the Dead'. (Acts 4:10) "God made Him Lord (Phil 2:11) and for everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved (Rm 10:13) Those who believe in Him, will have no cause for shame" (Rm 10:11) Wonderful way to practice our faith in Christ!

Therefore, Paul advised, "If you Believe in your Heart that Jesus is the Christ, and Confess that God Raised Him from the Dead, and Seated Him as Lord, then you will be saved" (Rm 10:9) We are made right with God for our faith and confession. Our faith and confession save us. Paul reiterates again, "Those who believe in Him will have no cause for shame, for everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be Saved" (Rm 10:13)

Christians' participation in the 'Christ Event' that is, his suffering, death, burial & resurrection' gives us New Life. We become 'New Creatures in Christ' (2 Cor 5:17) Through our Baptismal Ceremony, we die with Christ and Rise again for New Life. (Rm 6:4-6) Resurrection initiates this New Relationship with God and we begin to get to Know Him, Love Him and Belong to him. Our Union with God makes us 'Children of God' and We become the children of the Resurrection. We become heirs and co-heirs with Christ. We become 'Blessed' and are made eligible to be admitted into the presence of God. (Immortality & Eternal Life in God's Kingdom)

Heaven therefore is a place of fulfillment & contentment with Peace and Joy (Serenity).

Friendship with Christ helps us to follow the way of Christ, "Love one another just as I have loved you" (Jn 13:34) and get our entrance into heaven as a reward for following the ideals and value systems of Christ, who said "I am The Way, The Truth & The life". (Jn 14:4-6) Paul invites us to pray specially for our inner mind and vision to be enlightened to receive this blessedness. Ephesians 1:17-20 tells: "May He Enlighten the Eyes of our Mind" that is to 'open the eyes of our faith. Faith nourishes in this ability to understand our affiliation and closeness with the Lord. We become victors over 'Sin and Death' (1 Cor 15:55) In order to achieve this blessedness, God should grant us grace to open our eyes of faith to experience the glorious splendor of Heaven and heavenly bliss.

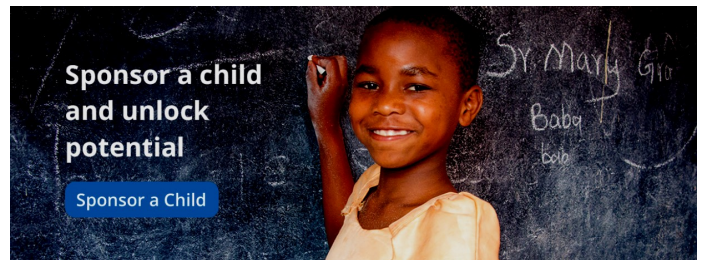

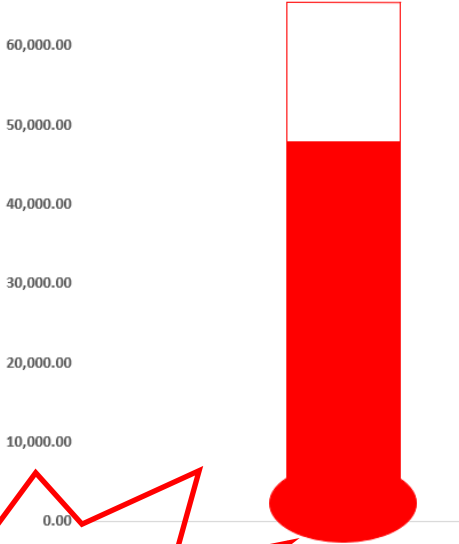

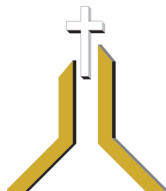
