PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord:

"Raising up our hands is a sign of Prayer" explains this week's Scripture. "Whenever Moses held up his hands, Israel prevailed". (Ex17:11) Keep your hands steady and call on the name of the lord! (Ps 18:6) Don't give up! "In my distress I called and to my God I cried. From His temple He heard my voice, my cry came to His ears".

Today's scriptures invite us to develop Perseverance & Consistency in Prayer. "Do not lose heart" (Eph 3:13) & "Develop devotion to Christ". (2 Cor 4:16) Paul encourages the believer to depend on God despite the challenge faced. 'Do not lose confidence' because 'the Lord listens to the cry of the poor' (Ps 34:18). Therefore, we are invited to pray unceasingly, without giving up or losing heart or confidence. But pray with humility of heart & soul.

In order to explain the importance of prayer, Jesus quotes the Persistent Request of the widow. (Lk 18:1 -8) She was very honest in her request. She did not bribe her judge for quick results. She did not have any influence to redress her case. But she depended on God with humble faith and trust. She was the 'anawim' / the little one of God, due to her helpless and hopeless situation. She believed that God would be able to vindicate her. Therefore, she unloaded her heart to God in prayer. She confided her agony & anguish to the Almighty and waited on His door steps for a favourable answer, not knowing when He would act on her behalf. Lk 18:9 Reflects this sentiment of the widow "Will He Delay?". God does not delay or postpone. He acts on their behalf readily and addresses their concern immediately.

Therefore, this passage of the Scripture develops Confidence, Trust, & Faith in God for the believer.

Our challenges, failures, limitations & etc., will soon be changed by the power of the Almighty in order to create that atmosphere of Support, that He cares for everyone who depends on Him completely with faith, hope, trust and confidence.

Perseverance is the great test of Genuineness in Christian Life. Perseverance in prayer reveals the quality of our faith. Perseverance proves that our faith is strong, real and it is deeper than just our lips. Mk 11:24 " Ask in my name anything you wish and believe in your heart that you will get it & it will be yours". So, we need to ask in Jesus' Name. Perseverance in prayer is a sign of our sincere faith.

Prayer is a Spiritual Exercise. We focus on God & not on what we want. Prayer builds up a relationship with Christ. The purpose of prayer is 'drawing closer to God'. Seeking His face / His Kingdom. If we are sincere, He will grant us.

Prayer is Submission to God & His Will. The goal of prayer is surrender. We surrender our pride to God and wait for His merciful gaze. When we spend time consistently in prayer, we will experience the power of God. The awe-inspiring presence of God will leave us breathless. Therefore, prayer is waiting on God like a waiter at table. 'We wait at the table of the Lord'. (Is 40:27-31) By waiting we gain strength, insight. We are refreshed in His Presence. The time spent on waiting should never be considered wasted, because the Lord gazed at us and read our heart / soul. He will quickly act on our behalf. Have Courage!
