#### **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

His Holiness Pope Francis extends a call for 'the renewed efforts to spread the Gospel', in his Mission Sunday message for 2022. He envisions a Completely Missionary Church and a New Era of missionary activity among Christian Communities. 'Every member of the Church has a shared responsibility to Witness Christ', the Pope said. "Go & Spread the Goodnews & Make Disciples of all the Nations". (Mt 28:19) This verse describes a series of ever widening circles from Jerusalem and finally to the ends of the earth. If this Goodnews has not reached its destination, especially your family, school, church, community, please make sure that you are contributing to the ever-widening circle of God's Loving Message through your participation.

The theme of this Missionary Month is: "You will be my witnesses". (Acts 1;8) One of the essential attitudes of every missionary action is Humility. For the mission belongs to Christ. The Holy Spirit inspires in us both the Will and Work according to his good pleasure. The Holy Pope John Paul II said that if we want to stand in front of humans, we should always kneel in front of the Lord Jesus. The seeds of the missionary action take root in a humble and docile heat to God and bears fruit within the Missionary Apostolate. It is important to be aware of the urgency of bearing witness to our contemporaries. All baptized people are called to be witnesses of Christ and to support the Universal Church in her mission. May Mary, the mother of all missionary disciples, intercede for us.

History of the Society of the Propagation of Faith:

Pope Pius XI in 1926 inaugurated this World event for the 'Wonderful Breakthrough of Radical Preaching of the Gospel of Christ', through our Missionary endeavour. This is a concerted effort of all the faithful from all over the world including all Christians and their local Churches.

Pauline Marie Jarcot, a 23-year-old French National born in 1799, wished for a Missionary Endeavour in the World around. She founded this Society with a Missionary Spirit to Spread the Gospel of Christ and called it "Propagation of the Missions "She was beatified on 23rd May 2022. "Pauline dedicated her life to the Missions, to the service of the poor and to prayer", the Pope wrote in a letter that was read at the Beatification Mass. The National Director Fr. Alex Osei reminds the words of Pope Francis: "May our charity be as inventive and effective as hers, let us learn to offer generously what we are, our talents to God, and to our brothers and sisters, especially the poorest, to give of our means to support the mission that is incumbent on all of us in the church to bring the Gospel to the World".
