PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ! "The depth of one's faith is known to one's heart", is the message of this week's scriptures. Our quality of faith is measured by our deep relationship and belonging to the Lord! Faith cannot be measured outwardly because it is the matter of one's heart and soul. What is faith? Faith is the hope and optimism that a Supreme Power/ Higher Power watches and guides all our pursuits. But the modern world is committed to undermine faith and promote doubt. Can we withstand this challenge and predicament?

Faith is understood as complete confidence/ trust in the Divine (God/Jesus/Trinity) The Hebrew Word "EMUNAH" that gives the meaning "Support". Therefore, faith is understood as 'Lord's support' (Divinity Supports the Believer). Paul asks in 1 Cor 6:19 "Don't you know that you are the temple of the Holy Spirit?". The Spirit of God is alive and active in the believer at all times and in every situation.

'Faith is God's gift to the Believer'. It is a free gift that God gives to those who Accept Him, His Teachings & Value Systems. People of faith should live and practice their faith consistently in order to activate & actualize their God experience. The Letter to the Romans 10:9 Explained that faith is the belief in Christ...'He is sent from God, (Christ is the Son of God), who Came into the World, Lived among the Humans, Suffered on our behalf on the Cross and Died. But God raised Him from death and seated Him at His Right Hand'. (Jn 3:16 & Phil 2: 6-11) If we believe this truth in our heart & proclaim /profess it with our mouth, We gain eternal Life & Immortality".

Our love for Christ is manifested in our abiding relationship. Our depth / intensity of faith is known to our heart. One's living faith is reflected in one's life, words, actions, attitudes & behaviors. Christian life is therefore rooted in our faith, reflected in our actions and dealings. The letter of James 2:17 Cautions us: "Faith without work/action is dead". Therefore, Paul in Galatians 5:6 encouraged the believers 'to engage in good works'. " Let faith work in Love/Let faith be reflected in Charity'.

How can we promote faith in our times? The best way to practice one's faith is to 'Love God and Neighbour'. (Mt 22:34-38) Another way is a humble witnessing Christian Life. (1 Jn 3:18) "Let not your love for Christ just be in speeches and words only Let it be expressed in Tangible Actions". Pope Francis explained it as 'exemplary Christian life & role models'. He also encouraged people to participate in the 'faith activities' especially Prayer, Fellowship, Charities & Humanitarian Endeavors. Most of all, the Pope asked the faithful to engage themselves in the Eucharistic Liturgy as often as they can to activate their faith.


