



PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

This week's Scriptures invite us to Develop Curiosity to explore the possibility of knowing new people, places, ideas & concepts from the Gospel of Lk 19: 1-10. Zacchaeus was a Chief Tax Collector and was rich. But he was short in stature and explored the possibility of seeing Jesus. His curiosity was so strong that he climbed a sycamore tree to see Jesus. (He had a childlike attitude to climb the tree & hid himself from the view of others) The name 'Zacchaeus' means, 'pure & innocent', but he engaged himself in unethical business dealings. In a way he was dishonest and cheated people by tax extortion. But Jesus surprised him when he met him face to face. Zacchaeus listened to Jesus and transformed his life and conduct. He became a model of practical piety because Zacchaeus volunteered to restitute; "Half of the possession I give to the poor, and he wanted to make good: "I will pay back four times those who have been defrauded by me". Jesus redeemed him by his benevolence & mercy.

Jesus offered to dine with him by showing him great love and concern. Jesus was able to share his compassion with Zacchaeus. Zacchaeus experienced the unconditional friendship of Christ at that moment. He tasted the merciful pardon of Christ and began to change instantaneously. "Charity absolves multitude of offences and Salvation is a free gift". God shares this free gift with those who seek him in their sincerity of heart. Reconciliation takes place through restitution and by their willingness to make amends, they redeem their souls.

Knowing people starts with connections, especially sharing their hopes and dreams.

1) Can we develop curiosity to know New People, Places, Ideas and Concepts?

Devices of modern life help connect with people especially Social Media & their Networking capabilities help us connect with strangers from the wider world. New people bring newness to our life and culture.

- 2)Our Curiosity to visit New Places, leads us to explore the unknown world around us. Modern Transportation facilitates people's travel to the unknown world to acquaint themselves with a new culture, language or some historical event. It gives them a sense of appreciation of other cultures, people's lifestyle, their dress, way of life and their food habits. Visiting other places broadens our outlook of the wider world & life.
- 3 Curiosity to know new ideas and Concepts lead to New Innovation, Research and Break-through's especially, Scientific and Technological advancements. Better medical care, effective disease control can lead to a healthier lifestyle for people. Better and advanced Technological devices could detect cyber-bullying and cyber-crimes & hacking. The advanced devices have impacted our present-day life considerably.

Jesus Ventured to know New People every day. He had the curiosity to get to know someone special every day in his life.

- 1. Nathanael (Jn 2:47) Jesus found him under the 'fig tree' / (a man without guile)
- 2. Jesus found the Samaritan Woman at the well (Jn 4:5) on a noon day.
- 3. Jesus found a Sick man at the Pool of Bethzatha (Jn 5:6) who was there for 38 long years and surprised him with a healing touch.
- 4. Jesus found a little boy at the outskirts of Galilee, running after the live stocks (Jn 6:10) and Jesus multiplied five loaves and two fish.
- 5.Jesus met Simon of Cyrene (Lk 23:26) on the Calvary Hills and surprised him.
- 6. Finally he met the Two thieves on either side of his cross and he surprised the one who asked him, 'Remember me when you come into your kingdom'. Jesus said, "Today, you will be with me in Paradise". (Lk 23:42) Let us invite the Lord to surprise us today in our life. Let us develop curiosity to get to know Him more and more.




PERPETUAL ADORATION CHAPEL




Circle Zacchaeus in the crowd. (Remember he was very small)
