PASTOR'S MESSAGE

"The Word of God Heals" is the message the Scriptures would like to share with us this weekend extending an invitation to listen to the Word of God daily and to act on it diligently for a healthier and happier life. The Word of God is the Power of the Divine, when received by the hearer with willing hearts, becomes equal to eating of the scroll (Eze 2:9 -3:3) and it tastes like honey in the mouth, but troubles/challenges the heart of the hearer/listener. God sends his Word to build and to plant, to uproot and to tear down, to destroy and ruin. (Jer 1:9-10) The Word of God accomplishes the purpose for which it is sent like the rain & snow that water the earth & refresh it. (Is 55:5-11) The Word of God refreshes the heart, soul & spirit of the hearers. It never returns back to God Empty.

The Word is the Operative Agent in human history (Creation of the World. Genesis 1-2) The Word of God has the Rebuilding Power of the broken structure of Israel, which motivated them to rebuild their temple and their faith in God/ Yahweh. God gives this Power to His human agents /delegates especially the Prophets, Kings, Priests and Ordinary people whom He selects at specific moments to give expression to His ideals & value systems to guide and lead the human race binding their wounds. God's Word has the Power to heal people from their sins/transgressions and ailments. It also has the Power to transform/change/ renew/refresh the hearts of people to become 'New Creatures'. (2 Cor 5:17) It is the Word that came from God motivated Elisha to pronounce the 'Healing Touch' to Naaman.(2 Kgs 5:14-17) and he felt that healing when he went into the river Jordan.

The Gospel of Christ is the Good News, which is the Power of God & the Wisdom of God (1 Cor 23-24)

Accepting the Word of God leads us to Salvation/ Eternal Life / Immortality. Jesus healed people because he is God's Son/ God Himself. Faith in Christ and in His power of healing is recognized by those who are touched by Him (from sin & sickness). Faith in Christ is the key to receive His Blessings! "Faith is the conviction that we would receive what we hope for / the assurance of the things that we hope for". (Heb 4:12) Faith in the Word of Jesus heals. Jesus' saving power of healing is experienced in the Sacraments of Reconciliation and in the reception of the Holy Eucharist primarily.

Faith impels the believer 'to recognize the healing touch of the Lord with a profound attitude of gratitude and moves that individual to express through the gestures of Gratitude & Trust' like the example of Naaman. Gratitude is a gift. It's a blessing from God. All good things come from God. Therefore, we need to be thankful to God always. It's not a onetime activity, but a lifelong endeavor. May the good Lord help to be thankful to Him all the time!




