PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ! "Social Justice" is a timely call for action. "Pure religion is based on Social Justice" (James 1:27) Society has an obligation to care for the Humans & Environment. The Bible teaches to care for the poor and the less fortunate/individual poor. But this concept of individual poor is replaced by 'social poor' by the 'Welfare State". According to the Bible, wealth is a blessing and not to be greedy about amassing wealth, but to be generous with the needy and poor. Share your plenty with the less fortunate. Be prudent managers of your wealth & riches.

Amos, the 8th Century Prophet observed the oppressive social structures of Israel (social injustices & class struggles) and condemned the violation of their social order. The poor were victimized by the rich. There were class struggles due to Social Distinctions. Religious decay was another root cause for this social crime. Amos, a straightforward person like John the Baptist was of the opinion, 'Worship has no value without morality'. Therefore, he encouraged the Israelites to mend, repent, and return to God, the Source of life. If they were to continue their malpractices of robbing and looting the poor, the 'Day of the Lord' (Judgement of God) would take over them. 'Manage your Wealth as Stewards' (Be prudent managers). Wealth is the driving force behind Socialism (Russia) and Communalism (China). The rich exploit the poor. So, we are reminded to care for the poor & needy. The Christian concept of Stewardship recommends and encourages the

sharing of wealth and riches especially with the less fortunate. The Church has developed a 'God Centered Social Justice'..."All are created in the image and likeness of God" (Ge 1;27) God is the Creator, Provider and Saviour. Therefore, our value system should be "Love, Justice and Peace" (Rm14:17)

Treat everyone equally with dignity, respect and honor. Show Love, Empathy, Mercy and Compassion. Don't mistreat another human being. We mistreat another human being when we exploit either them or their resources.

Mining Companies around the World exploit the poor by deforestation, causing serious havoc to the Ecosystem & Natural Resources like water, air, wood, beauty & minerals. (Ex: Amazon Forests) Another serious social ailment in our modern world is "Human Trafficking" which is also called 'Sex Trade/ Slave Trade' which exploits the poor especially the economic poor of our societies. (Ex: Mexico & S. Africa) 'Denial of Global Warming' is also a Social Crime of the 21st Century. 'Our Common Home is the Earth and we are harming this great planet by damaging the Ecosystem', laments Pope Francis. We cause irreparable damage causing unintended misery to the system and its people.

Therefore, this week's Scriptures invite us to feel our responsibility and obligations.... 'Building a Social Structure with the Solid Foundation of Social Justice'. Let us Create a Society that treats everyone with equal opportunity and rights to live & exercise their god given gifts and talents with 'Freedom of Conscience'. Let us envision a World Community based on Human Brotherhood & Sisterhood and not on the imbalances of the rich and the poor or the haves and have nots. We are children of God and so we commit ourselves to give expression to this vision of the Church.
