Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

"Apathy & Indifference" (Lack of Love & Concern) are the greatest evils in the world today expressed, Saints Mother Theresa and John Paul II. This Sunday, Scriptures explore & reflect this insensitiveness of those who just live in their own world. Such people have no clue as to the living conditions of people. Luxury oftentimes led to indolence (lazy & idle). They are locked up in the life of ease/complacency/self-centered/self-righteous and egoistic living. Luxury should help people with the ability to understand the suffering of the poor, especially the less fortunate/have-not's'.

The distance between the rich & poor/have's & have-nots are growing wider every day. The Church encourages us to explore the possibility of 'Bridging this Distance' by our profound gestures of love and concern. In our Canadian Context a) Several Hundred Thousand people are living on the Streets /Homeless. About Three Million are more Canadian families living in overcrowded housing conditions. b) 64% of the Food Banks are helping primarily the First Nations and those who are on the streets') 21% of the Single parent households are living in poverty and in less/unfurnished houses (squalid conditions) raising their children. d) Individualism seems to be the life-style of the moderners and they do not care / recognize the existence of people around. e) Seniors' needs are either neglected or deliberately delayed by those who are responsible to care for them.

How can we solve Apathy? 1. We need to recognize apathy in our life. We may have to make an examination of conscience. a. Do I have concern for my family, friends, children and neighbours? b. Do I care for my elderly parents especially when they need my assistance. c. Does apathy rob my family stability & peace? Are we conscious of our family situations? Are we able to quickly address such situations in a positive way? d. Does your family life & love have a purpose? Has it become cold overtime? Have you become an island by yourself? Can you be able to rekindle the sense of purpose to care for your family? e. What about the broken relationships / connections between siblings and other family members? Has your passion for your family wanning steadily? Have you become selfcentered? (Living in illusion or in a different world) Some have become 'Don't touch me & I don't care'. People are occupied, preoccupied, selfabsorbed and blinded from the reality of life & cannot look beyond their life.

Let us consider 'Spiritual Apathy'. Spiritual Apathy can affect our Faith life too. When our faith becomes cold, we develop a feeling of disinterest in the Church practices. Our love for the Lord diminishes steadily and we are on the slippery slope. We succumb into sinful behaviour, hostile thoughts and give way to a life of disconnect from the deity. Our passion for the Lord is waning. Revelation 2 & 3 Chapters explain how our love for the Lord becomes cold / boring overtime. Therefore, today's scriptures invite us to have a Renewal experience through Repentance of our lethargic attitude and the Spirit to Rekindle our Spiritual Enthusiasm to activate our Christian Commitment of Love of God & Neighbour.


